

# 2017-2018 Sophomores

(You must know what Endorsement you are pursuing.)

Forms are due to your English teacher by **Monday February 27<sup>th</sup>**.

*Please write your student id# and last four digits of your SS# on your course request form. Please have a degree plan from the college you plan to attend or if you do not plan to attend college and idea of your post high school plan.- This will help you with your course selections.*

1. Core courses you must take for a total of **four credits**:
  - a. English 2 or English 2 Honors
  - b. Geometry
  - c. World Geography
  - d. Biology(if have not taken) or advanced science
  
2. Please consider the following courses if you have not yet taken them:
  - a. Health/Speech (Prof Comm)
  - b. BIM
  - c. PE
  - d. Spanish 1
    - If taking Spanish 1, Spanish 2 should be selected on your course request form.
  - e. Fine Arts- Band, Theater, or Art
  
3. Look at the “Endorsement with Possible Courses” list. Each endorsement along with endorsement options is listed. Under each endorsement and option, you will find the list of courses we offer to fulfill your endorsement elective credits. **This list can be found on the school’s website: Canadian High School>Parents/Students>Course Guide/Request Information** (Multi-disciplinary students can choose from courses across any endorsement.)
  
4. Select your electives. Pick **at least one elective credit** within your endorsement area. Please refer to the “Endorsement with Possible Courses” list for a list of courses within your endorsement. The remaining elective can come from any other endorsement area.
  
5. After course selections are made (core and electives), you should have a total of **eight credits (4 core and 4 electives)**.
  
6. Please handwrite **three alternative courses** on the back of your course request form.
  
7. Parents must sign your course request form.

Course Guides with a listing of all available courses and an overview are available from Mrs. Walker or on the school’s website. If you have questions about your endorsements, talk to Mrs. Walker. Don’t forget about the new Gateway to Health Career courses being offered again next year.
